12. PARTICIPANT FEE	The Tournament Director will assess a \$2.00 Participant Fee to each Stacker in the Tournament (this fee is added to the Individual's Registration Fee). The fee will go to the WSSA to help defray the cost of the Tournament Packet, StackTrack Software, Participant Ribbons, maintenance of loaner equipment, website posting of Tournament results and record keeping.	\$1.00 Participant Fee.
