After a count, then a recount, WSSA Executive Director Mark Lingle boxed up the official Guinness Verification Forms and sent them certified mail to the Guinness office in New York City on November 26th. Confirmation of receipt was given by Brian Reinert from Guinness, who said it "looks great." He also said the contents would be reviewed quickly and logged by Guinness representatives in the United Kingdom. Once the number is official, Reinert said the record will appear in the Guinness World Record Book published in September 2009 in the Guinness World Record Day section and within its own record category. 2008 WSSA STACK UP! FACTS

- Total # of US states represented: 50 (199,659 stackers)
- Total # of other countries: 13 (22,901 stackers)
- Next largest country represented: Canada (16,326 stackers)
- American state with most stackers: Texas (24,522)
- School with most stackers: Sampson Elementary, Cyprus, TX (1,653 stackers)
- Country with smallest number of stackers: Malaysia (7 stackers)
