



# WORLD SPORT STACKING ASSOCIATION "STATE/PROVINCIAL/REGIONAL" TOURNAMENT REQUIREMENTS A Sanctioned WSSA Event

## **Choose Tournament Date and Venue**

Venue must be the size of a large gymnasium (recommend 2 gymnasiums) and have bleacher seating available for Stackers and spectators.

## **WSSA Tournament Application**

Fill out the WSSA Tournament Application and fax or mail back to the WSSA.

## **WSSA 'Tournament Finder' Posting**

Your tournament & contact information will be posted on the WSSA web site's 'Tournament Finder' (after Application Approval).

## **Tournament Planning Committee**

Forming a Tournament Planning Committee is recommended to help with tournament planning and implementation.

## **Contact Organizations in your State/Province/Region**

Contact the WSSA to receive your list of sport stacking organizations in your state, province or region. Plan on contacting every organization on the list via mass mailing, email, by phone call or by fax.

## **WSSA Rule Book**

All Tournaments must abide by the WSSA Rule Book. Download your copy of the WSSA Rule Book from the WSSA web site ([www.worldsportstackingassociation.org](http://www.worldsportstackingassociation.org)).

## **Records**

Potential State/Provincial, National and World Records can be established. You must follow the Records/Procedures outlined in the WSSA Rule Book (pages 8-9) and the Video Verification Procedures.

## **Age Divisions & Events**

Must offer all Age Divisions, all Timed Events and 1 Head to Head Team Relay Event. (See the WSSA Tournament Age Divisions & Events, page 13-14 in the WSSA Rule Book)

## **Tournament Forms**

All Tournament Forms (General Information, Registration Forms, Volunteer Forms, etc.) must be sent to the WSSA for approval three months prior to your event. After the forms are approved, they will be posted on the WSSA web site for Stacker access. Note: Please send in Word and not in Pdf. format.

## **Liability Insurance**

Check with your venue contact and find out whether you need a Liability Insurance Policy. If you do, contact the WSSA about obtaining a Liability Insurance Certificate.

## **StackTrack Tournament Management Software**

Windows 2000 (Service Pack 4), Windows XP (Service Pack 2) and Mac OS X 10.3.9 System Requirements.

## **Equipment**

Speed Stacks, StackMats and Tournament Displays are designated as the official sport stacking equipment for a WSSA Sanctioned Tournament.

## **Loaner Equipment**

Loaner Speed Stacks, StackMats, Tournament Displays and Super Stacks are available to you from the WSSA.

***You are responsible for the shipping cost to and from your tournament.***

## **Rental Equipment**

Video cameras, tripods and tape are available. (Rental fee: \$20.00/camera includes shipping and handling)

## **Awards\***

See the list of minimum Award Requirements.

### **Tournament Fee**

You will assess a \$4.00 Participant Fee to each Stacker in the Tournament (this fee is added to the Individual's Registration Fee). After your tournament you will inform the WSSA how many Stackers attended your event and then you will receive an invoice for the Participant Fees.

### **Tournament Pack**

Because a Tournament Fee is being assessed you will receive the following items:

  2. Judges Training Presentation DVD's
  3. StackTrack Tournament Management Software
  4. Loaner Referee Vests
  5. Loaner WSSA Banners
  6. Loaner Speed Stacks Banners

<b>Overall Individual 3-3-3, 3-6-3 &amp; Cycle</b>	<b>Award top 3 with trophies</b>
<b>Overall Doubles</b>	<b>Award top 3 with medals (2/team)</b>
<b>Overall Timed 3-6-3 Team Relay</b>	<b>Award top 3 with medals (4/team<sup>2</sup>)</b>
<b>Individual 3-3-3, 3-6-3 (per division)</b>	<b>Award top 3 with medals</b>
<b>Individual Cycle (per division)</b>	<b>Award top 3 with trophies</b>
<b>Doubles (per division)</b>	<b>Award top 3 with medals (2/team)</b>
<b>Timed 3-6-3 Team Relay (per division)</b>	<b>Award top 4 teams with medals (4/team<sup>2</sup>)</b>
<b>Team Relays: 3-3-3, 3-6-3, Cycle (per division)</b>	<b>Award top 4 teams with medals (4/team<sup>2</sup>)</b>

<sup>1</sup>(Optional Award) The Stacker who accumulates the lowest combined time from their 3-3-3, 3-6-3 and Cycle stacks during the finals.

<sup>2</sup>Note that some Team Relays have 5 Stackers so you will need an additional medal/team.
