



## Your kids love sport stacking. Now take the next exciting step... **Host a WSSA Sport Stacking Tournament!**

### “Why should I host a tournament?”

- Because kids love sport stacking and would like the opportunity to compete!
- A WSSA Sanctioned event gives the opportunity to set official State/Provincial, National & World Records.
- Receive recognition for your school/organization as your tournament will be promoted on the WSSA web site.

### “How do I start?”

Contact the WSSA for the **WSSA Tournament Application** and additional Tournament information and support. **You decide...**

- on your Tournament **date** and Tournament **site**.
- on your Tournament **Age Divisions** (from 4 & under to Seniors) and **Events** (Individual 3-3-3, 3-6-3 and Cycle; “Doubles”; Team Relays). (See WSSA Age Divisions and Events--WSSA Rule Book for details).
- on your Tournament **Level** (Sanctioned or Recognized). (See WSSA Sanctioned and Recognized Tournament Requirements available on the web site or contact the WSSA)
- on your Tournament **Places** (i.e.: 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place, etc.) and Tournament **Awards** (choices--prizes, ribbons, medals and trophies).

### What does the WSSA offer for Tournament Support?

The WSSA has **everything** you need to help plan, organize and host a **successful** tournament!

**The WSSA Rule Book**—which includes all the rules for sport stacking, procedures for setting official records, specifications on equipment and set up including layout of the Official Sport Stacking Court and a list of the Age Divisions and Events.

**Tournament Guide**—to help with planning the WSSA Tournament.

**StackTrack Tournament Management Software**—to help manage your tournament the WSSA has the StackTrack which takes the Stacker's Registration information and their times during the competition and creates a Leader Board, Individual and Team Results and Tournament Reports.

**Judges Training Presentation DVD**—helps prepare you and your volunteer judges to officiate all tournament events.

**Loaner Equipment**—to help with your tournament equipment needs the WSSA provides you with Loaner StackMats, Loaner Tournament Displays, Loaner Speed Stacks® and Loaner Super Stacks®.

**(Note:** The Tournament Packet, StackTrack and Judges Training Presentation DVD's are available to you at no charge. But you are responsible for the shipping costs to and from your tournament for the loaner equipment.)

### “This sounds great! What do I do next?”

- Step 1: Contact the WSSA (email: [pmetz@worldsportstackingassociation.org](mailto:pmetz@worldsportstackingassociation.org) or call 303-962-5654 for the WSSA “Sanctioned” or “Recognized” Tournament Requirements and the WSSA Tournament Application.
- Step 2: Review the WSSA Tournament Requirements and the WSSA Age Divisions and Events (in the WSSA Rule Book) and determine which Tournament Level best suits your tournament plans.
- Step 3: Fill out the Tournament Application and fax it back to the WSSA (303-962-5650). Once the Application is received and approved, your tournament information will be posted on the WSSA web site's 'Tournament Finder'.
- Step 4: Study the information in your Tournament Guide and begin planning, organizing and promoting your tournament.
- Step 5: Contact the WSSA for your copy of the StackTrack Tournament Management Software and Judges Training Presentation DVD.
- Step 6: Make arrangements for loaner equipment to be sent for your tournament.
- Step 7: Stay in contact with the WSSA regarding your tournament planning and organization. We are here to help!
