TEAM RELAY EVENTS: All teams may compete in two relay events – One head to head to head relay (H-T-H) and one Timed Relay. (Note: A 6U team who wants to compete in the H-T-H 3-6-3 Relay may do so by “playing up” into the 7U Division.) Our team will compete in the following **checked** Relays. **Make sure your team signs up for the Timed 3-6-3 Relay!**

- Timed 3-6-3 Relay (All divisions including 6U) H-T-H 3-3-3 (6 U only)
 H-T-H 3-6-3 Relay (All divisions but 6U) Special Stackers Timed 3-6-3 Relay (special stacker teams only)

Teams must field a complete roster of at least 4 Stackers to compete. Teams with less than 4 Stackers will be disqualified. (Teams of 5 are encouraged, but not required, to assure participation incase a team member cannot attend the competition. If all 5 are present, the 5th Stacker can be rotated in.
