Highlights



◆ AGE LEVEL DIVISIONS FOR ALL EVENTS!

A stacker's Age Divisions coincides with their age on the day of the tournament (March 13). Stackers will compete in the following Age Divisions—4 & under, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13-14, 15-18, Collegiate (19-24), Masters 1 (25-34), Masters 2 (35-44), Masters 3 (45-59) and Seniors (60 & above). Special Stackers will compete in the following Age Divisions—6 & under, 7-10, 11-14, 15-18 and Open (19 and up)

◆ THE 3-3-3 INDIVIDUAL TIMED EVENT NOW OPEN TO ALL AGE DIVISIONS! (Previously for PreK and K only.)

◆ 3-3-3 TEAM H-T-H RELAY EVENT FOR THE 6 & UNDER DIVISION!

◆ "DOUBLES" COMPETITION (See WSSA Rule Book for details.) Top 3 "Doubles" Teams in each Division will advance to the Finals.

◆ 3-6-3 TIMED RELAY COMPETITION. Relay Teams will work together and race for their team's fastest time in the 3-6-3 Relay!

◆ We are having the 2010 NW Region / Washington State Sport Stacking Championships at Auburn High School.

◆ Registration fees: This year our fee's are \$15.00 per contestant, and \$10.00 for special stackers. General Admission (\$5.00 for adults// \$2 for students, age 6-17) fee will be charged at the door for all spectators. (Competitors & Volunteers FREE!)

◆ The 'New' Generation 2 StackMat Competition Timer will be used this year along with the Tournament Display.

◆ Submit all Team, Individual, Doubles, and Special Stackers forms and fees as soon as you are able. The registration deadline for John Ansotigue to receive completed forms and fees from you is to be postmarked by Friday, February 26th.

We anticipate a number of schools to be represented this year at the Championships. For those of you planning to attend "participation is the name of the game!" You might bring five kids. You might bring 150.

A note to schools not quite ready to compete: Even though you may not have had a chance to really build a sport stacking program at your school, we want to encourage you to simply come and observe our 5th annual tournament. This will give you the opportunity to see the potential of this exciting sport at your school. If you are unable to attend, perhaps you have some students who would like to come with their parents. Please get the word out to them. They don't need to be super fast to participate. **Participation by everyone is our goal!**
